Morning

Life at Paul Nelson Farm follows a rhythm that is entirely its own. Early risers are rewarded with the sounds of the South Dakota prairie waking up around them — an unhurried morning stroll, a cup of fresh-brewed coffee by the fireplace, and the quiet anticipation of the day ahead.

A homestyle hot breakfast and coffee awaits in the Main Lodge. For those who want to sharpen their eye before heading to the field, professional shooting instruction is available daily at the Sporting Clays Barn starting at 8:00 a.m.

When the buses pull up to the main lodge, you'll gather your group and join your professional hunting guides and their well-trained bird dogs. In minutes, the South Dakota sky erupts with the brilliant colors of ring-necked pheasant. This is your world for the next three hours.

Afternoon

Your morning hunt is followed by a satisfying lunch back at the Main Lodge, a chance to return a few calls, take a walk to Paul's Pond for a bit of bass fishing, or simply rest in your private room.

Then the afternoon hunt begins, another three hours of exceptional shooting in the heart of pheasant country, each hour passing faster than the last.

Evening

After the hunt, relax at one of our eight fully stocked bars where there is never a shortage of the right beverage for the right moment. Hot hors d'oeuvres are served during the cocktail hour as guests gather by the fireplace or the outdoor fire pits to relive the day.

Dinners at Paul Nelson Farm are events in their own right — Paul's famous prime rib, pheasant and wild rice, and pork chops — served alongside 90-point wines, homemade desserts, and after-dinner drinks at your group's private table to cap your night.

Lodging

Paul Nelson Farm offers 35 private sleeping rooms, each with its own private bath, spread across three distinct lodge settings: the Main Lodge, the King Lodge, and the Buffalo Lodge. Every room is appointed with plush bedding and premium linens, designed to ensure a quiet, restful night on the South Dakota prairie.

Common areas throughout the property invite guests to gather and unwind in their own way — whether that means settling into a chair by the fireplace, relaxing in the spa, watching a game on the movie theatre screen, hitting the exercise room, playing table shuffleboard, or enjoying one of the designated smoking lounges. The lodge is yours.

The Range

For those who want to push beyond the field, The Range at Paul Nelson Farm offers one of the most extraordinary shooting experiences in the country. Our state-of-the-art 2,000-yard long-range rifle facility is unlike anything most sportsmen have ever encountered. Under the guidance of our world-renowned firearms expert — you'll progress through a full day of training and shooting, starting at 100 yards and building toward the ultimate challenge: a one-mile shot.

With a maximum of 12 shooters per session, every participant receives personalized attention and coaching. You and your partner will work as a team — shooter and spotter — developing a bond forged through focus, precision, and the shared thrill of hitting targets at distances most people only read about.
